Dear Parents and Guardians:

Thank you for continuing to do your part to help our school stay open for our students. In order for us to continue to successfully stay open for in-person instruction, please remember the following:

- 1) If any member of your household tests positive for COVID-19, all children in your household are required to quarantine and should not return to school until the quarantine period is over. Please be sure to let the school nurse know if someone in your household tests positive so that we may work through the Oneida County Health Department quarantine dates and procedures with you, for your child.
- 2) If your child is exhibiting any symptoms, please keep them home, call your health care provider, and call the school nurse. In addition, if anyone in your household is exhibiting symptoms, please keep your child home from school until you discuss the same with your health care provider and/or the school nurse.
- 3) If you use a home test kit for COVID-19 that indicates a positive result, please be sure to contact the Oneida County Health Department immediately.

<i>If your child is required to be on a precautionary quarantine, you will receive a call from RCS as soon as possible and also from the OCHD when they are able.</i>	
OCHD Low Risk Exposure Self-Monitoring Awareness	
If your child is in a class or on a bus listed below, you will need to monitor your child for COVID-19 symptoms for a 14-day period starting on the date indicated above. During this period, please check your child's temperature twice daily and watch for COVID-19 symptoms. Should your child develop a fever or any symptoms, your child should stay home, isolate, and you should contact your healthcare provider for guidance and if able, get your child tested. During the self-monitoring period your child can continue their routine activities, including attending school, unless they develop a fever or other symptoms.

Due to privacy laws, we are not able to share the identity of the individual or share details of their case. If you are notified that your child must be placed on a precautionary quarantine and would like to pick up meals for your child, you may do so between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM at the back door of the high school cafeteria kitchen on Mondays and Wednesdays when school is in session. Please be sure to wear a mask when knocking on the back door to pick up meals.


